I-DEAS 12 Rollout Weekend – June 9-11

I-DEAS 12 will be rolled out over the weekend of June 9-11. Upgrade instructions for end users have been posted at <http://www-cad> and have been copied below for your convenience.

Overview of Upgrade Process

The I-DEAS 11 to I-DEAS 12 upgrade process will be done in multiple steps over a period of time. This is done to allow enough time to troubleshoot failed installs in advance of the database (TDM) upgrade.

First, I-DEAS 12 will be deployed to all I-DEAS 11 PCs before the upgrade weekend. A new set of **Program Groups** will appear in your **Start Menu** in the format of **I-DEAS12-TEAM_ID** where *TEAM_ID* is the TDM name. For example, **I-DEAS12-FERMI**. All I-DEAS users will have the FERMI TDM configured on their PC along with their local group TDM. However, the **I-DEAS 12** and **Drafting Standalone** Shortcuts will not function until after the TDM upgrade on June 9-11.

Second, all 5 TDMs (FERMI, ADCS, ADMS, PPD, & TD) will be upgraded at the same time on upgrade weekend. From this point on, I-DEAS 12 will be used for accessing the TDMs. I-DEAS 11 will no longer be able to access the TDMs.

Third, I-DEAS 11 will be uninstalled on all PCs except for those collaborating with DESY using their EDMS system. A list of these users will need to be provided to the Lab CAD Manager so that steps can be taken to allow these users to continue using I-DEAS 11.

Pre-Upgrade Steps for Users

There are some pre-upgrade steps that need to be done by each user. These are:

1. Users will need to **check-in their data** and **delete all unnecessary model files** on or before **Friday, June 9th at 4pm**. Unnecessary model files are defined as model files that are more than a few weeks old AND contain data that can be checked into a Project/Library for safe keeping. Necessary model files are model files in which a user is actively working OR contains data that cannot or should not be checked into a Project/Library.
2. Users with custom files located in the I-DEAS 11 install path, C:\ideas\i11, should copy them to another directory to prevent them from being deleted by the I-DEAS 11 uninstall process.
3. Users need to be out of I-DEAS as of **4pm on Friday, June 9th**. Any users still in I-DEAS after this time risk losing data.
